GREETINGS FROM CONSISTORY, March 15, 2024

To keep everyone up to date on happenings at St. Paul's, I plan to write this column each month during our transition time. If any of you want to know about something I haven't remembered to tell you, please read the minutes from each of the Consistory meetings posted on the bulletin board next to the office. Also, if you have any positive suggestions, feel free to speak with Steve Leinbach, Daryn Keim, or myself.

As I have mentioned during worship and at Consistory meetings, <u>our</u> <u>church activities going forward will require a team effort</u> on the part of all members. Currently, the Consistory and Transition Team are working closely with the Covenant Association and the PA Southeast Conference of the UCC to follow the guidelines to complete a "short" church profile based upon the wants and needs of the congregation.

On February 24 the Consistory met with Reverend Kevin McLemore, the Search and Call Minister of PSEC. On April 10, he also met with our Transition Team to advise on the process of updating our "short" profile in order to begin a search for <u>an interim pastor</u>. This pastor <u>will help us in resolving issues so our church will heal, be stronger and more attractive to potential candidates for a full-time settled minister position.</u>

Also at the April 10th meeting, the Consistory was joined by two members of the Covenant Association to go through the "Exit Interview." The basis of this meeting was to discuss what we need more of in the church, what we need less of, and what we want to stay the same. The minutes of the exit interview will be posted on the bulletin board.

Following this meeting, the Consistory will ask all members of the congregation to complete a survey. The survey will include the same questions that were discussed at the Consistory. Each member will receive by email or a written notice in the church bulletin. Please respond with open thoughts and feelings and put your name on your submissions. We need everyone's participation so that the Transition Team will have a better idea of what St. Paul's wants to be in the future and what our expectations are for a new pastor.

With God's help let's practice loving each other, forgiving 70x7, and working with a unified effort toward becoming stronger and a more loveable body of Christ. As Rev. McLemore said, "We need to remember that church is a place of love-to love God and each other," to build each other up.




