God has blessed St. Paul's with a new Interim Pastor, Reverend Deb Timmins. By accepting our Interim Pastor, we have agreed to a covenant between the Pastor and the congregation of St. Paul's: a shared promise.

Jesus gave us a new commandment that "you love one another." In the United Church of Christ, covenant is a promise among individuals and various settings of the church to love and support each other, while also holding each other accountable. Covenant encourages us all to work together to discern God's will, not only within our congregation, but with our association and conference. - Guide us at looking at five key areas: heritage, mission, leadership, connections, and future-discernment of future (vision)







She also likes "Precious Lord, Take My Hand," found on page #684 in our hymnal. Whenever Ethel feels low, the words to this hymn speak to her and raise her spirits. This hymn reminds her of the gospel music she heard while growing up in Texas.

"Precious Lord, Take My Hand" was published in 1938. The music is by George N. Allen and the words are by Thomas A. Dorsey. The lyrics of this hymn call out to the Lord for guidance and strength through difficult times. As Dorsey experienced tragedy in his life, he turned to God for hope and faith. This hymn has been described as "the greatest gospel song of all time." Dorsey

was influential in the development of early blues and twentieth century gospel music. He wrote 3000 songs, many of them gospels. May this hymn help you through difficult times to trust in God.
